Dear Colleagues,

On behalf of the Organizing Committee of XLVI ESNA Meeting it is our pleasure to invite you to Wieliczka near Krakow, POLAND.

Krakow, Royal City is a historical capitol of the Poland Kingdom. Nowadays, Krakow (web site: <http://www.krakow.pl/english/> is the main city and capitol of Malopolska region (www.visitmalopolska.pl) which is located in the south of Poland and has many tourist attractions.

The city of Wieliczka is located 13 km of the southeast of Kraków. Under the town is the Wieliczka Salt Mine (<http://www.wieliczka-saltmine.com>) – one of the world's oldest operating salt mines which has been in operation since prehistoric times.

Kraków's historic centre, which includes the Old Town, Kazimierz and the Wawel Castle (<http://whc.unesco.org/en/list/29>) and Wieliczka Salt Mine (<http://whc.unesco.org/en/list/32>) were already included on the first list of UNESCO World Heritage Sites in 1978.

The organizers of the ESNA 2017 meeting are the Agricultural University in Krakow, Malopolska Association for Agricultural Extension and Scientific Centre for Biotechnology of the University of Agriculture in Krakow.

The history of agricultural studies in Krakow began in 1806 when the Chair of Farming was established at the Krakow Academy (the Jagiellonian University). During 1890-1923 the Agronomy Studies were part of the Faculty of Philosophy at the Jagiellonian University. The Faculty of Agriculture was set up in 1923 (the Faculty of Agriculture and Faculty of Forestry since 1949). This faculty was transformed into an independent University of Agriculture in 1953 (more historical information on the web page: <http://en.ur.krakow.pl/>).

At present, Agricultural University in Krakow named after Hugo Kollataj educates about 11,000 students at 7 faculties and University Centre of Veterinary Medicine JU-UA in 24 major fields and above 60 specialisations.

Malopolska Association for Agricultural Extension (MAAE) was established in 1993. The main goals of the MAAE are: creation proper conditions for development of agricultural extension, and agricultural education; better using of intellectual and research potential of the University and research institutions.

Agricultural University in Krakow and Malopolska Association for Agricultural Extension were already organizers of the XXXVIII ESNA Meeting in 2008.

Following the decision of the General Assembly taken in Belgrade the XLVI ESNA Meeting is organized in Wieliczka - Krakow, and the common scientific activities will regard:

Galleries full of exhibitions, cafes, pubs and restaurants: all of this is an integral part of any visit to Krakow. And all this is merely a modest part of what we can offer travellers seeking exciting destinations on the world map.

Wieliczka is a small town (22,000 inhabitants), picturesquely situated in a valley between two ridges of hills, 13 km southeast of Kraków. Under the town is the famous Salt Mine – one of the world's oldest operating salt mines. However Wieliczka, it is not only Salt Mine. Here are also Żupny Castle, wonderful polychrome wooden church of St. Sebastian (XVI century), the baroque Franciscan Monastery (Small Assisi), three old synagogues, parks and sports facilities.

A four star **Hotel Lenart** (<http://hotellenart.pl/en/>) embodies modernity, luxury and style. It is situated at the heart of historic town of Wieliczka and perfect links with the Krakow. A world famous Salt Mine or the Saltworks Museum are situated within a few minutes' walk from Hotel. TRAVEL INFORMATION

CLIMATE:

In August the temperature usually fluctuates from +10/12°C at night up to +15/25°C in the daytime, rains are quite possible.

CURRENCY

The tender in Poland is the Polish zloty (PLN)

Currency exchange facilities are available at several domestic and international bank branches and exchange offices in the downtown.

HOW TO GET to Wieliczka and Hotel Lenart?

By plane:

Cracow has its own international airport, appropriately named after the Pope, John Paul II, who was born near the city. Almost all the major airlines such as British Airways and Lufthansa fly to Cracow with the budget airlines appearing in greater and greater numbers (Sky Europe, EasyJet, Ryanair, Central Wings etc.). A number of routes also land at nearby Katowice, such as the ones offered by Wizzair from London, Paris and Barcelona. Once you've arrived at Cracow Balice you shouldn't have any trouble continuing your journey.

The fast, cheap and comfortable train departs from Airport arrives directly to Hotel Lenart!!! The station "Wieliczka Park" is about 200 m from Hotel. The ticket is 11 PLN (about 2.5 €) and the service runs about every 30 minutes (from 5:47 to 22:47) taking 40 minutes to get there <https://malopolskiekoleje.pl/>.

Taxis are still relatively cheap in Poland and you can book one online or grab one from the rank for around 70 PLN into Krakow or 140 PLN in to Wieliczka.

By train

You may travel by train from all main cities in Europe to the Krakow main station (Krakow Dworzec Główny) and next change on train to station "Wieliczka Park". The ticket is 3 PLN (0,7 €) service runs about every 30 minutes (from 5:47 to 22:47) taking 20 minutes. Hotel Lenart is 200 m from Station. From Krakow Railway Station you can also run by bus No 304 (agglomeration line) from Bus stop "Dworzec Główny Zachód" (from 4:30 to 22:45 to the ticket is 4.00 PLN) to Bus stop "Wieliczka Park" (taking 45 minutes) or in the night by bus No 904 (from 23:50 to 3:50, one to the ticket is 4.00 PLN to the bus stop "Wieliczka Kościół" (taking about 60 minutes)

Prepare for a five hour journey from Wroclaw, seven hours from Poznan and eleven hours or more from Gdansk. The express between Cracow and Warsaw is the exception with modern intercity trains taking about three hours to complete the 300 kilometres distance. Find precise details by checking out the timetables courtesy of the Polish Rail Network (PKP). Just remember to use the Polish spellings (ie. Krakow for Cracow, Warszawa for Warsaw). Backpackers will be interested to know that there are also overnight trains to and from Prague and Budapest.

By bus:

You may travel by bus from all main cities in Europe. For instance, from London it takes 24 hours to reach Krakow Regional Bus Station which is situated in Bosacka St. 18. Busses are quite comfortable and relatively cheap.

By car:

When you decide to travel by car you should know that the western and southern borders you can cross without stoppage and custom checking (Poland is in Schengen Zone). You will need an international certificate of insurance cover, and possibly proof of exhaust emission control on your car. Spot checks on vehicles by grim-faced police are common, and if you plan to stay in central Krakow or Wieliczka, remember that much of it is pedestrianised, or has prohibitive parking restrictions. However, around the Hotel Lenart there is a huge free parking area (for 150 cars) where you will be able to park your car. The GPS date of Hotel Lenart is N: 49° 99' 04" E: 20° 04 '93"

HOW TO GET TO THE Hotel Lenart?

We kindly ask you to inform the Local Organising Committee of the date of your arrival to Krakow. We need info on your flight number at least five working days before the arrival. The Organizing Committee will arrange your transportation from airport to the hotel by car. But we are convinced that you do not need our assistance since you can go by bus or train the centre of Krakow by yourself.

LOCAL TRANSPORT

For local transport you can take the bus and taxi. Bus tickets should be bought from in the traffic and ticket machine immediately after boarding. The cost of single ticket is 3.8 PLN per trip (0.90 €) or 2.8 per 20 minutes (0.65 €). There are many taxi companies in town (the telephone number you will get in the hotel), the price from the Railway Station to the Hotel Lenart in Wieliczka is about 15-20 €).

PASSPORT AND VISAS

To arrange visa support the participants are kindly requested to inform the Organizing Committee of their personal data. All participants and accompanying persons should have a valid passport. The Visa Registration Form, duly filled up as well as a scanned copy in JPG format of the most important pages of the passport has to be sent before May 1, 2017 to the Local Org. Committee. In addition, if you do not apply for the visa in your native country, a scanned copy of the document permitting your stay in that country is also necessary. Letters of invitation provided by the Local Org. Committee can be used for visa formalities if necessary.

All participants and accompanying persons must have a valid passport.

INVITATION LETTER / CERTIFICATION OF ATTENDANCE:

The Organizing Committee will send letters of invitation to persons wishing to take part in the Conference. These letters will be provided to help participants raise conference attendance funding and to obtain visas. A certificate of Attendance will be issued for the registered participants upon request. A receipt of the registration fee and accommodation will be given to all participants.

GRANTS

A limited number of grants is available for young researchers coming from the JINR member countries, thanks to the financial support provided by the Joint Institute for Nuclear Research. Typically we would expect the support to be restricted to accommodation expenses. It can be extended to (partially) cover travel expenses in exceptional cases.

The applicants for grants have to send the APPLICATION FORM FOR GRANT (accessible at ESNA web site), a short curriculum vitae (including age and relevant experience) and the abstract of the paper they want to present, to the chairperson of the ESNA working group and also to the ESNA secretariat in Brno, before 1st May 2017. The basic criteria for the grant are: ESNA membership, age and quality of submitted paper. Priority GRANT applications will be able via e-mail. The ESNA secretariat will select acceptable applicants in co-operation with the chairpersons before 15 May 2017. The ESNA President, Prof. S. Grego will give his final approval and send the list of selected grantists to the Local Secretariat. The Conference secretary will set up the final list and the order of the grant receivers in June 2017.

Any applications for grants submitted after the deadline (1st May 2017), and those that do not meet all the required criteria, will not be accepted. After receiving the grant, the grantists are urgently requested to inform the Local Secretary by e-mail or fax immediately that they accept the grant and that they will attend the Conference. If they fail to do so, their grant will be cancelled.

BORKOVEC TRAVEL SCHOLARSHIP

To commemorate our late General Secretary, Vladimir Borkovec, a travel fund towards the cost of travel has been established to provide some support for young scientists who are members of ESNA and are presenting a paper at one of our annual meetings. Application should be made on the APPLICATION FORM FOR BORKOVEC TRAVEL GRANT (accessible at ESNA web site) including a short curriculum vitae and abstract of paper they want to present, and sent to the Secretariat in Brno for consideration before 1st May 2017. The number of travel grants is dependent on the very limited means of the sponsors and donors. Priority BORKOVEC TRAVEL Grant Applications will be enabled via e-mail.
